The privacy statement explains what information we collect from our members and users and what is available to our users and members.

The information we collect

We require the users to register with us in order to access our games. For this, we collect the personal information of our members, including their name, address, and telephone number. If you do not provide the required information you may not be able to access the features and services. We also collect personal information such as your IP address. Such information is not associated with your personal information and cannot be used to identify you. We use this information to analyze trends, administer the site, track user's movement, and gather broad demographic information for aggregate use. A23 is the sole owner of the information collected on this site (a23.com). We will not sell, share, or rent this information. This information is disclosed in this statement.

A23's usage of the information collected

A23 (a23.com) does not disclose your personal information to any third party without first receiving your permission. We may need to disclose your personal information to be shared and/or used as stated in this privacy policy. We may need to disclose your personal information to improve our service and your experience on our sites and provide our users with new offers, products, and services. We may also disclose your personal information to sponsors and suppliers of prizes for our winners available through our site. A23 has the required security to protect your information. Your registration data is password protected where only you can access your information. A23 is not responsible for the use of your password. We suggest you not to disclose your password to anyone.

Children's Privacy
